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### Test Results:

#### 1. European RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU Annex II; recasting 2002/95/EC

Cadmium, Lead, Mercury, Hexavalent Chromium, Polybromobiphenyl (PBB) and Polybromodiphenyl ether (PBDE) content

Method :

For Lead, Cadmium : With reference to IEC 62321-5:2013, analysis was performed by Inductively Coupled Plasma Optical Emission Spectrometer (ICP-OES) / Atomic Absorption Spectrometer (AAS).

For Mercury : With reference to IEC 62321-4:2013+AMD1:2017, analysis was performed by Inductively Coupled Plasma Optical Emission Spectrometer (ICP-OES).

For PBB and PBDEs : With reference to IEC 62321-6:2015, analysis was performed by Gas Chromatography Mass Spectrometer (GC-MS)

For Chromium (VI) : With reference to IEC 62321-7-2:2017, analysis was performed by Ultraviolet Visible Spectrophotometer (UV-Vis)

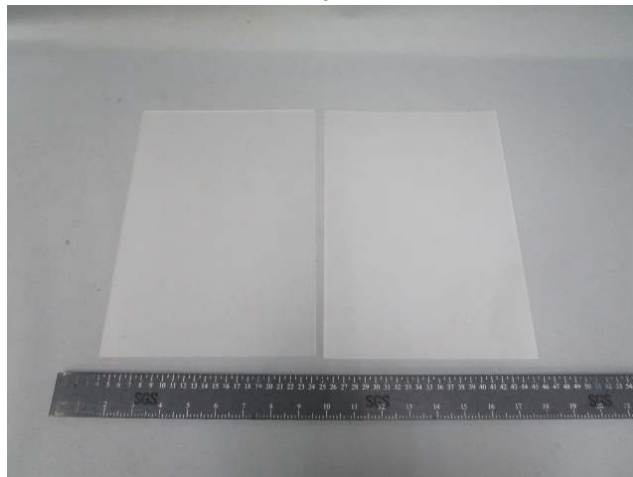

“Inconclusive – It is not possible to state the conformity. Either one or more measured values were observed in the portion of the expanded measurement uncertainty intervals at the points tested where the specific risk is up to 50%.”
